For submitting project proposals for TRAIL'22

The TRAIL'22 workshop will welcome students and researchers working in teams on the projects selected from the proposals received in reply to the Call for Projects. In order to achieve successful projects, proposals should be designed in such a way that their objectives are clearly stated and the proposal reflects the estimated progress of the projects in details, so that these are ready to launch and terminate on time. Therefore, we recommend project proposal documents should include the following content:

- 1. Title page: name of the project, principal investigator and candidate participants, and an abstract;
- 2. Project objectives (max 1/2 page): providing the rationale for the proposed project;
- 3. Background information (max 1 page): a brief review of the related literature, so as to let potential participants prepare themselves for the workshop;
- 4. Detailed technical description and work plan (max 3 pages):
 - a. Technical description
 - b. Resources needed: facility, equipment, software, staff etc.
 - c. Project management
- 5. Benefits of the research (max 1 page): expected outcomes of the project

Please describe the tangible results to be achieved at the end of the Workshop: software components to be included in the TRAIL factory, and how the project contributes to the TRAIL grand challenges.

NB: we insist that all the data and software components used for the project, and all the software built during the project should be free for use, and available as such to all participants (after the workshop, too).

- 6. Profile of team:
 - a. Leader
 - b. Staff proposed by the leader You may propose some members of your future team if you are certain they will also participate in the workshop.
 - c. Other researchers needed
